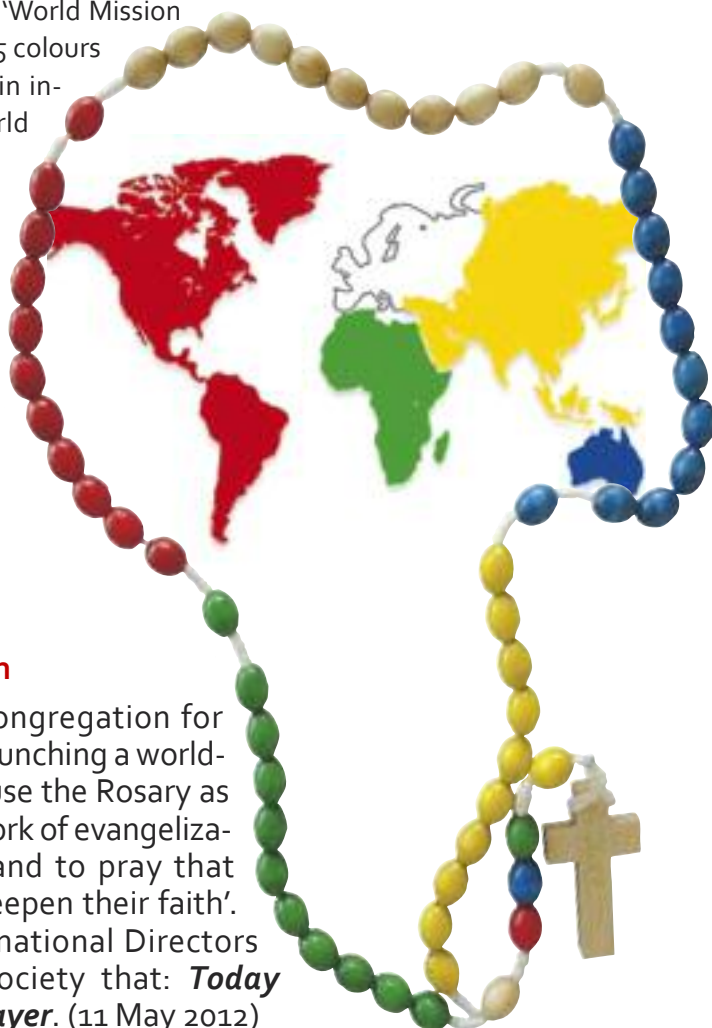
AFRICA - green

Worldwide Prayer Campaign
